Weighing will begin at 8 a.m. Monday June 7th through 4 p.m. Tuesday June 8th. We are NOT weighing the towed vehicles as this would require more time. Please complete this form BEFORE YOU ARRIVE. The form will be submitted to our weighing volunteers before you are weighed. You will receive your weights (last page of this form) immediately after weighing.

Please fill in all the information as accurately as possible.

This information will be given back to the rally attendees as a series of analyzes based on models and years.
